- The above information you provided is honest and truthful, any omission of information and/or failure to answer all the questions can result in this application being declined. We believe in treating each adoption and adopter on an individual basis.
- Please note, that the animals in our care have uncertain pasts. We do our best to guess age/breed/size, but we can never be certain. We also cannot guarantee health or temperament.
- All of the cats/kittens that are up for adoption we have had initial or full vetting completed.
- Kittens will be adopted out prior to 6 months of age; however, the adoption agreement and adoption fee being completed, we will follow up with you near the 4-5 month of age mark to book a vet appointment at our designated vet clinic and will coordinate having the kitten(s) spay/neutered (this cost is included in our adoption fee).
- All adult cats will have had vaccines, de-worming and spay/neuter completed prior to adoption.
- We recommend following your vet clinic's protocol on continued vaccines and yearly checkups. We also
 recommend to research pet insurance (check online or your own car/house insurance company) to cover
 costs if anything happens in the future, or alternatively set up a savings account for your pet to cover vet
 appointment costs or any unforeseen emergencies.
- If there are other pets in the home, we will assist in a transitional process to follow to ensure the introduction of a new pet goes successfully. This can take time depending on age and temperament of the current pet. Please be committed to the process, this can be very stressful. Reach out for help if you are having any issues, we can often assist by providing resources or guidance.
- **Return Policy** Please contact the adoption coordinator and we can have a conversation of the situation and locate a new foster home. Please understand that adoption fees are non-refundable as adoptions and returns take time and resources to process, care for and adopt out again.
- We do not allow adoptions of pets as gifts for someone else.
- Anyone who is renting, please ensure you contact your landlord or condo board to ensure you are allowed a pet and check if there are any restrictions regarding size or pet related damage deposits.
- All of our friendly cats are to be indoors only. (Outdoor acceptable with leash and harness or Catio)
- Kittens under the age of 6 months will need to go to a home with a feline companion or be adopted in pairs. Kittens require stimulation and interaction with other cats/kittens. This will allow them to be happier, entertained while you are at work and be more socialized.

Adoption Process:

Someone will be in contact with you within 24-48 hours. We will go through a follow up discussion and will email you back with a meet and greet.

Once a decision is made, we will follow up with you on the status of your application. If approved, we will set up time for the adoption coordinator to bring the adopted kitten(s)/cat to your home. This will be a home visit along with providing guidance on how to integrate your new adoptive pet into your home.
